### ABOUT SOUTH ISLAND

From New Zealand's cool, windswept South Island coastlines to South Africa's rugged slopes, great Sauvignon Blanc is a shared vineyard treasure for both nations. Porcupine Ridge has been perfecting the art of great Sauvignon Blanc since 1996, and now these two wine worlds come together in this exceptional expression of Sauvignon. To realise the vision, Marc Kent travelled to the heart of Marlborough to source the style and quality that would play the perfect counterpoint to the famed and perennially popular Porcupine Ridge Sauvignon Blanc.

### TASTING NOTE

The nose is intense, inviting and expressive with its pungent aromas of gooseberry, cut grass and white asparagus. The green fruits and bell pepper of the nose follow through onto a lively, light-bodied palate with classic tropical notes of juicy passion fruit, fresh lime and lemon verbena. The mid-palate is zesty and vibrant, with its high, yet integrated, balanced acidity, adding to the refreshing quality. Greengage and lemongrass linger on a clean, dry finish.
